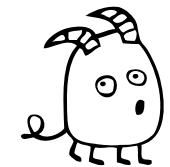

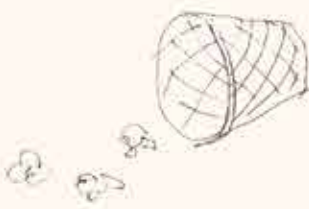
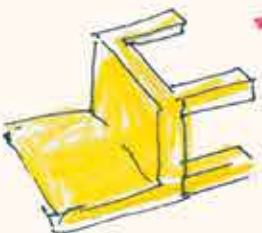


Got a problem

strange voices!

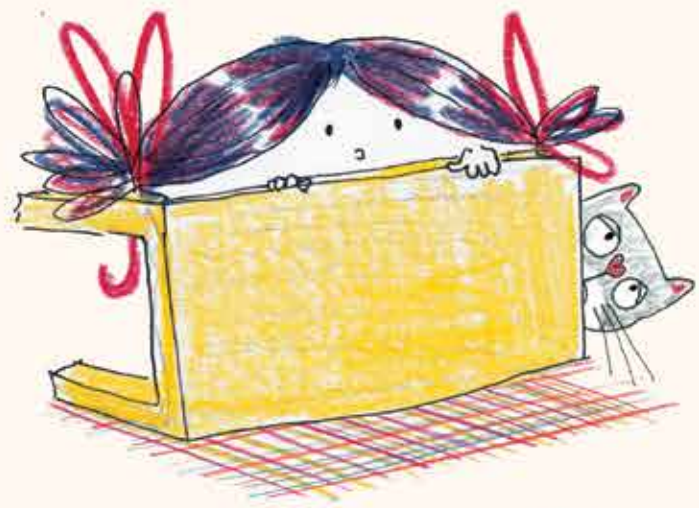


Don't panic!
